



# What is housing discrimination?

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Discriminatory housing practices include discrimination in the **sale or rental of housing**, discrimination in the **provision of brokerage services**, or interference, coercion, or intimidation on the basis of: **race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability or familial status.**

It is illegal to discriminate in the sale or rental of housing, including against individuals seeking a mortgage or housing assistance, or in other housing-related activities.
